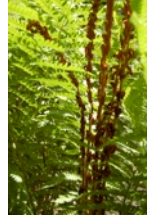


## Native Ferns

### Cinnamon Fern *Osmunda cinnamomea*

2-5' tall  
 Shade tolerant  
 Prefers stream banks, bogs, swamps and acidic soils  
 Matures by mid to late spring  
 Cinnamon-colored fronds  
 Attracts ruffed grouse and hummingbirds



### Hay-scented Fern *Dennstaedtia punctilobula*

12-18" tall  
 Full sun  
 Prefers open woods  
 Lacy, triangular light green fronds



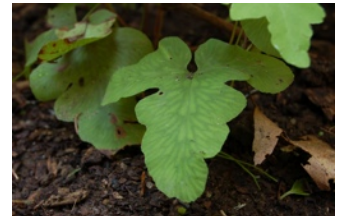
### Ostrich Fern *Matteuccia struthiopteris*

3-5' tall, 5-8' wide  
 Part shade to full shade  
 Prefers rich, constantly wet soil  
 Grows in v-shaped clumps



### Sensitive Fern *Onoclea sensibilis*

3-4' tall and wide  
 Part shade to full shade  
 Prefers slightly moist, well-drained acidic soil



### Christmas Fern *Polystichum acrostichoides*

1-2' tall and wide  
 Part shade to full shade  
 Evergreen, stays green all winter  
 Prefers dry to medium rich woods and open woods  
 Will rot if too wet
