

## Deciduous Shade Trees

### Red Maple *Acer rubrum*

Native

40-70' tall

Prefers moist acidic soil but adaptable  
Full sun but tolerates partial shade  
Fall color varies from greenish yellow to  
Vibrant scarlet to burgundy



### Sugar Maple *Acer saccharum*

Native

75' tall

Prefers well-drained, moist fertile soil  
Full sun but tolerates shade  
Excellent yellow, orange or red fall color  
Not tolerant of road salt



### White Oak *Quercus alba*

Native

50-80' tall & wide

Prefers deep, moist, well-drained acidic  
soil

Full sun

Long lasting purple/red fall color  
One of the most attractive oak  
Difficult to transplant



### Swamp White Oak *Quercus bicolor*

Native

50-60' tall & wide

Prefers moist, acidic soil

Part shade to full sun

Exfoliating bark

Moderate growth rate

Attracts Monarch Butterflies



## Deciduous Shade Trees, cont.

### Red Oak *Quercus rubra*

Native

60-75' tall & wide

Adaptable to all soils but prefers acidic, well-drained sites.

Full sun

Fast growing, needs ample room to develop



### Scarlet Oak *Quercus coccinea*

Native

75' tall, 45' wide

Prefers moist, acidic, well-drained soil

Full sun

Brilliant fall color lasting 3-4 weeks.

Difficult to transplant



### London Planetree *Platanus x acerifolia*

75' tall

Moist, fertile soil, adaptable

Full sun

Exfoliating bark reveals creamy yellow inner bark

Great for difficult growing sites



### American Sycamore *Platanus occidentalis*

Native

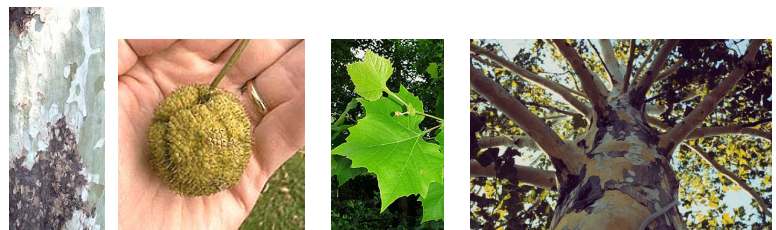
75-90' tall, 60-70' wide

Moist, rich well-drained soil

Full sun

Exfoliating bark reveals red to gray-brown color

Salt and drought tolerant



## Deciduous Shade Trees, cont.

### Green Ash *Fraxinus pennsylvanica*

Native

60-70' tall, 45' wide  
 Moist deep fertile soil, adaptable  
 Full sun  
 Fast growth rate  
 Yellow fall color, showy



### Thornless Honeylocust *Gleditsia triacanthos inermis*

Native

50-60' tall and wide  
 Prefers deep, moist, fertile soil  
 Full sun  
 Clear yellow fall color  
 Thornless variety  
 Tolerant of salt



### Black Locust *Nyssa sylvatica*

Native

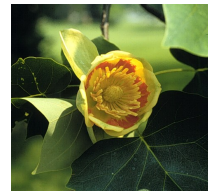
30-50' tall, 20-30' wide  
 Prefers well-drained, acidic deep soil  
 Full sun  
 Slow growth rate  
 Very showy fall foliage



### Tulip Tree *Liriodendron tulipifera*

Native

70-90' tall  
 Prefers deep moist acidic soil  
 Full sun  
 Blooms late May through mid-June  
 Most flowers are borne in higher reaches so not easily observed  
 Showy fall yellow color



Additional Choices: American Beech, Bitternut Hickory
